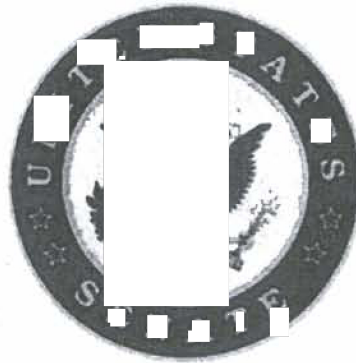

PART 2 - DOMESTIC SECURITY

02. The Congressional committee charged with the oversight of the Intelligence Community considers and is responsible for the activities, programs and policies executed by the Intelligence Community. The legal obligation imposed by section 102 of the National Security Act of 1947 is to keep the Intelligence Community "fully and currently informed" of all U.S. intelligence activities (excepting secret activities that are covered by section 105) including "significant unreported intelligence activities" and "significant intelligence failures." The oversight process provides a necessary check and balance at the community level of the Intelligence Community, occurring between the Office of Intelligence Programs (OIP) and the Office of Intelligence Requirements (OIR) - an appropriate dialog with national policies. The relationship between the Intelligence Community and the Congressional oversight is mutually-beneficial. The obligation of the oversight is to ensure the national security, and it must be vigilant for potential abuse - particularly in the area of civil liberties.

03. BEING THE MAIN RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT

The DOD is responsible to the President for the performance of the entire Intelligence Community as an entity and to ensure, ultimately, that decisions are made - in the White House - in the field - as provided necessary through intelligence. This entails supervision and oversight of all aspects of the activities: collection and analysis, resource management, intelligence policy development, operational effectiveness, and compliance with the law. The DOD also serves as the primary intelligence advisor to the President and is responsible for ensuring that the Congress is able to carry out its oversight of the Intelligence Community.

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
