Opening Statement to the House Select Committee on Intelligence
Concerning Hearing to be Conducted on Intelligence
Spies
January 2010

This witness, Michael Sussman, Chairman of the
Senate Select Committee on Intelligence, has been retained by
President Barack Obama to advise the Administration on matters relating to
intelligence and national security.

Sussman is a public interest lawyer who previously served as an attorney at the Department of Justice and the FBI. He also has taught as a visiting scholar at the University of Pennsylvania Law School, the University of Virginia Law School, and Georgetown Law School.

I called Sussman to advise the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence on January 12, 2010, to brief the panel on the legal and ethical issues surrounding the conduct of intelligence operations. I have been in contact with Sussman since that time, and we have discussed the legal and ethical issues surrounding the conduct of intelligence operations. We must also consider giving the new Office of National Intelligence the capacity to conduct financial audits of intelligence professionals working overseas. and either. This would only happen if the court would be satisfied by the evidence that it is reasonable to infer from the witness's statement that he or she is telling the truth. If the court accepts this evidence, it may then consider the witness's statement in arriving at its decision. Given the gravity of the issue, I would expect that the court will give considerable weight to the witness's statement.

In addition, some of the powers which your committee has given to the police have been described above, basically as follows. I have particular regard to the right under section 1(1) of the Criminal Justice Act 1993 to search a person lawfully if there is reasonable suspicion that he or she has committed an offence. According to the code of practice, this is legal and lawful if the officer who has the power, reasonably believes that there is evidence of an offence. I have thought carefully about this change and I believe that it is important that the changes will not affect people, as I believe that no option of greater control over the carrying forward of the law

on the behalf of the police will be available to your committee, given the obligation which the code of practice places on the police to make a reasonable and proportionate assessment of the circumstances of the individual case.

Modified legislation will help to ensure that the original proposal is considerably lessened by having the power to search a person lawfully if there is reasonable suspicion that he or she has committed an offence. This will give the police the ability to take action where a suspect is armed or threatening the public. Such legislation should also provide for carrying out controlled trials of intelligence

in the House of Representatives on December 1980. The speech will be
an introduction to the new administration and its political
priorities to the rest of the world. It can also be delivered
in the Senate on January 1981.
