ARTICLE I

SECTION 1. THE LEGISLATIVE POWER SHALL BE VESTED IN A SENATE AND A HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, WHICH SHALL BE CALLED THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

SECTION 2. THE SENATE SHALL BE COMPOSED OF SENATORS WHOSE QUALIFICATIONS AND ELECTIONS SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS: SENATORS SHALL BE AT LEAST THIRTY YEARS OF AGE, AND SHALL HAVE BEEN SEVEN YEARS IN THE UNITED STATES, AND TWO YEARS IN THIS STATE, BEFORE THEY TAKE THE OATH OF OFFICE. THE SENATE SHALL BE Elected BY THE PEOPLE OF THE SEVERAL COUNTIES, AND SHALL BE HELD IN REGULAR SESSION ON THE FIRST MONDAY IN JANUARY OF EACH YEAR, AND MAY BE ADJOURNED TO ANY OTHER DAY IN THE MONTH OF MARCH, BUT NOT MORE THAN FORTY DAYS.

ARTICLE II

SECTION 1. THE EXECUTIVE POWER SHALL BE VESTED IN THE GOVERNOR, WHO SHALL BE Elected BY THE PEOPLE OF THE SEVERAL COUNTIES, AND SHALL BE HELD IN OFFICE FOR FOUR YEARS, AND MAY BE RE-ELECTED TO ONE TERM MORE.

SECTION 2. THE GOVERNOR SHALL BE THE COMMANDER IN CHIEF OF THE MILITARY AND NAVAL FORCES OF THIS STATE, AND SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO PARDON AND REPRIEVES OFFENSES AGAINST THE LAWS OF THIS STATE.

SECTION 3. THE GOVERNOR SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO RECOMMEND TO THE LEGISLATURE ANY MEASURES HE MAY DEEM ADVISABLE.

SECTION 4. THE GOVERNOR SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO SIGN OR VETO ANY BILL PASSED BY THE LEGISLATURE.

SECTION 5. THE GOVERNOR SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO PARDON AND REPRIEVES OFFENSES AGAINST THE LAWS OF THIS STATE.

SECTION 6. THE GOVERNOR SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO RECOMMEND TO THE LEGISLATURE ANY MEASURES HE MAY DEEM ADVISABLE.
