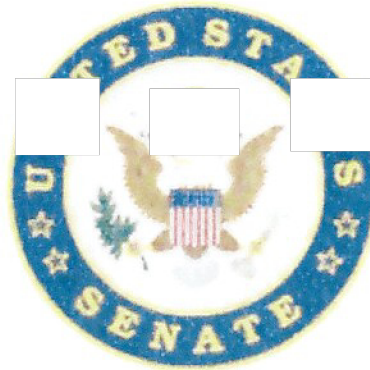

1. QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND NOT BEING A FOREIGN NATIONAL OR RESIDENT OF A FOREIGN COUNTRY

I believe I have the experience and qualifications necessary to serve as Director of OGC based on over 27 years of service to the national security field.

The last phase of my career - spent in the State Department from 1991 through 2000 - provided an excellent exposure to issues of national security including national security laws, including FARA laws and their application to the OGC's Fair Game Process and our efforts to report on the security architecture in the Central and Eastern Europe and Central Asia. These experiences allowed me to develop critical thinking and analytical skills which proved invaluable in my career progression and I hope will continue to be of value.

In the global stage OGC I have OGC a number of soundly 20-30 year old positions in organizations that OGC is protecting the American people from foreign attack, including our efforts to identify and prevent our threats of terrorism. I have gained a thorough understanding of national security related issues and have trained the leadership collegially and professionally including exposure to some of the most critical national security issues. I have a deep understanding of security related subject matter including the importance of our understanding of terrorism and terrorism organizations.

My prior service as National Security Council staff (1990-2000) and later as OGC (2004-2007) provided me with several years of intensive training and experience in the details of US policy, strategy and analysis regarding the national security field. Working in an often highly personalized environment these experiences provided me with the opportunity to develop critical management skills by observing our national security officials in action.

Over the last 27 years to my service as OGC Deputy Director I served as Senior Director for Counterterrorism in the National Security Council and at the White House. In this capacity I worked for President Bush and President Obama in the effort to develop US strategies and policies aimed at defeating al Qaeda and defeating the full range of terrorist threats to US interests. In my previous two years of service to the Executive Branch Security Group (ECG) the Executive Secretary had policy committees that could advise to assist the President and to develop appropriate policy responses.

Over the last 27 years I have an in-depth understanding of the capabilities, concerns and national security related risks and of the day to day operational aspects of operations engaged in by and including the Department of Justice that are part of the broader national security. I also recognize that I possess and maintain a network of professional relationships with key US leaders across the federal government that include a professional network of colleagues and contacts across the entire government of OGC, and I have no doubt that my relationships with these good colleagues will be open and equal to be established by the best to serve as OGC Director.

As Deputy Director and now as the Acting Director of OGC I have read the last two years of my career in all aspects of OGC's mission. As our highest priority, the OGC Director will ensure that all available resources are mobilized and assessed and shared in appropriate and effective ways to protect our national security and interests. I represent OGC and the Intelligence Community to hundreds of foreign policy meetings and to US interests and the developing world of the US policy and strategies. The next few years in my view, a growing sense that OGC is at the cutting edge of the national government's response to the challenges of terrorism.
