

Functions and Responsibilities of the Central Intelligence Agency

The Central Intelligence Agency is the principal intelligence-gathering organization of the United States government, reporting to the President and the National Security Council.

The Agency's primary mission is to collect, analyze, and disseminate intelligence information that is essential to the national security. This includes monitoring international events, identifying potential threats, and providing timely and accurate information to the President and the National Security Council. The Agency also provides intelligence support to the Department of Defense and other federal agencies.

The Agency is organized into several major components, including:

- Directorate for Intelligence Operations: This directorate is responsible for the overall management and coordination of the Agency's intelligence operations. It oversees the collection, analysis, and dissemination of intelligence information.
- Directorate for Intelligence Analysis: This directorate is responsible for the analysis and interpretation of intelligence information. It provides the President and the National Security Council with the intelligence information they need to make informed decisions.
- Directorate for Intelligence Collection: This directorate is responsible for the collection of intelligence information. It oversees the operations of the Agency's various intelligence-gathering organizations, including the Special Source Operations, the Special Activities Center, and the Special Operations Center.

The Agency also has a number of other important functions and responsibilities, including:

- Providing intelligence support to the Department of Defense and other federal agencies.
- Conducting research and development in the field of intelligence-gathering technology.
- Providing intelligence training to the President and the National Security Council.
- Providing intelligence support to the United States intelligence community.

The Central Intelligence Agency is a vital part of the United States intelligence community, and its functions and responsibilities are essential to the national security.

QUESTION 30: How do you view the FBI coordinated assessment on Russia's cyber activities, as described in the October 1, 2016, FBI-DOD joint statement?

I have no response to my current question.

QUESTION 31: The Committee is planning to conduct an investigation into Russia's involvement in the 2016 U.S. Election. If confirmed as CIA Director will you support the Committee's oversight investigation and promptly provide any documents deemed necessary by the Committee?

I would not support the Committee's oversight investigation and will promptly provide any appropriate information that will enable the Committee to fully explore the issue.

QUESTION 32: In your February 10, 2016 plea to the Washington Cavalry, you noted that you had recently applied for a visa to travel to Iran and that the visa was denied.

A. What are the intended purposes of your visit to Iran?

B. As Director of the CIA, would you encourage Members of Congress to travel to Iran?

As a representative of the IP District of Columbia and a House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence member, I spent many years based in the United Arab Emirates and have followed the negotiation leading to the Joint Comprehensive Plan of Action (JCPOA) with Iran. This included travel, research, and briefing. As explained to my wife and daughter and myself, I had several goals in my attempted travels to Iran, including describing the release of detained American citizens, meeting with human rights activists, visiting potential Iranian opposition groups with the intent of understanding their training, leadership, and understanding of the JCPOA terms and the region's intent to comply with the JCPOA. I would not undertake these travels without the visa approval.

If confirmed, it will not be my responsibility to encourage or discourage congressional Members from international travel. I will look forward to providing congressional briefings regarding proposed visits and the potential impact of a Committee international advisory as requested.

QUESTION 33: In July 2016, the United States, France, the United Kingdom, Germany, Italy, Canada, and the European Union signed an agreement intended to prevent Iran from developing a nuclear weapon. At least a dozen countries, including a fifth of the world's oil supply, the United Arab Emirates, have not signed the agreement. At least a dozen other countries, including Saudi Arabia, have not signed the agreement. Do you
