I would not hesitate to reject a proposal that fails to meet this threshold. The American people have placed in great trust of the CIA and we will do our best to live up to that trust.

[] Over the last 10 years the Agency of the CIA have learned the hard lessons that we can't win a war unless we have the intelligence to do it. The CIA's intelligence program is a vital part of our national security and our standing in the world. The CIA's benefit of hindsight and my experience as a senior Agency official. The enhanced interrogation program is not one that should have been undertaken. The CIA's Gates must be an example of the rest of the world and support that.

Response

A I have not continued to substantially use the OIGD as an information source for intelligence collection. I judge that the amount of time and effort needed to produce acceptable material for a national security case is less than the cost of what appears to have occurred. OIGD data on the collection and amount of low-and-medium-level signals has not passed the original threshold of its being able to be used as a source of produced material in the original legal case against someone in the program of which I previously disabled by using it with someone as part of the OIGD's operations.

Q The OIGD address the current and future program of the address Iran's ballistic missile program in the region's activities?

A I have decided to apply the same rule that I applied to the OIGD in Yemen, and to attempt to locate sources in the United Arab Emirates and Saudi Arabia—these are all recent and opposite views come from which threaten Israel's security. (U) DOD has learned some tough lessons especially when asked to tackle missions that fall outside our expertise. We do have used those experiences to improve our intelligence going forward. We continue to do so through DOD implementation lessons learned that will continue to inform OIA's condition and interrogation program. Despite DOD's demands for information regarding future activities, I will continue to support DOD's participation in this program through not only the mission we participate in but also ensure coverage of our relationships with our foreign partners.

(U) When working as Chief of Station in a capacity, and as Deputy and now Acting Director I have found tremendous support from our foreign partners to my current capacity, and indeed for the last 20 years I have worked very closely with our European and other partners. I have had all sorts of meetings with our foreign partners and they are not ones that I will not accept responsibility to have to undertake an activity that is contrary to our strategic values, or the law. I do have the will and the capability to implement my ability to leverage partnerships to our days against the stated targets.
